Fall Athletic Events: Protocols and Procedures

In accordance with the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH), the Center for Disease Control (CDC), and the Alabama High School Athletic Association (AHSAA), the Athletic Department for St. John Paul II Catholic High School and Falcon Middle School Program has instituted the following guidelines to protect all players, coaches, staff, officials, and attendees of athletic events held on our campus.

General Guidelines:

1. All spectators are required to wear a mask or facial covering **at all times** at any athletic event.
2. Spectators should follow physical distancing guidelines.
3. Before attending any athletic event, please self-screen yourself and any accompanying attendees for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. Please refrain from coming to the event if you are experiencing any of the symptoms.
4. We will serve pre-packaged concessions at most events and offer vending machines at events where concessions are not provided.
5. All children must remain in the bleachers with family and may not play in open areas or in the lobby.
6. All spectators must exit the facility immediately after the contest.
7. There will be one door/gate designated solely for entry to the facility and another separate door designated solely for exit.
8. Only essential personnel are permitted on the field or court before, during, and after the event.
9. Hand sanitizer will be readily available at several locations inside the facility.
10. Bathrooms are available for use but we ask that you please practice social distancing.

- Varsity Football: Adults- \$10, Students- \$6
- Middle School Football: Adults- \$6, Students- \$4
- Varsity/JV and Middle School Volleyball: Adults- \$6, Students- \$4



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Football Guidelines:

- Max capacity for the stadium given the COVID-19 restrictions is 1,000 attendees including all coaches, players, band, etc. (families can sit together but must distance from separate households).
- There will be no charge for parking.
- Restrooms are available at the South endzone but ask that 6ft. distancing is maintained.
- All spectators will exit the stadium at the single gate facing the gym on the south side of the stadium.
- We will serve concessions, but will have a reduced menu that will only include pre-packaged items.
- Our concession workers will wear a mask and gloves and must go through the COVID-19 screening before being allowed to serve items.
- The visiting team bleachers are located on the same side of the press box.
- **Visiting Team:**
 - All athletes should go through the Covid-19 screening before being allowed to travel.
 - Buses will drop off players in the parking lot and all players/spectators will enter the stadium through the double gate on the east side of the stadium. Buses will park on the west side of the gym by the dumpster area.
 - Opposing teams are required to arrive to competition dressed and ready for play, as locker rooms cannot accommodate a full team given the distancing restrictions.
 - The visiting locker room is split between the two locker rooms on each side of the concession stand in the south endzone. It is highly recommended that players come dressed and ready to play. It is recommended that the visiting team staggers the players getting dressed by position group or alphabetically if they need to do any last minute equipment/jersey changes.
 - Only essential team staff members will be allowed on the sideline during competition.
 - Opposing teams will be responsible for providing and developing their own hydration plan for their athletes.
